Parent Observations

One of the ways in which your child's progress is assessed in preschool is through collecting evidence of things they have said or done. These are put into a 'learning journal', which is simply a 'scrapbook' of your child's achievements.

Throughout their time at preschool this evidence is used to work out your child's learning and their next steps.

As part of this tracking your child's development we love to have parental input in the learning journals - this means we want to know what you can see your child doing at home! Parental input is vital as it can demonstrate skills that, for whatever reason, might not have been observed at school and they allow us to get to know your child even better!

Attached to this newsletter is a 'parent observation' form. Simply spend a few minutes watching your child and write down what you see them doing, or alternately, write down a recent 'WOW' moment, something new that you have noticed your child do. For example, you might write something like:

'Jessica told me 'you have to wear a hat outside when it's sunny or you might get sun burnt' or 'Jamie brushed his teeth by himself this morning'

We look forward to reading all your observations and WOW moments!
